## **A little about the event:**

Presented by Lexus and Wolberg Electric, The Capital Cup for Kids returns to the ice April 21-30, at the Albany County Hockey Facility in Albany, NY. This marks the 16th edition of the premier adult hockey fundraising event in Upstate, NY. The Capital Cup for Kids was founded to connect our adult hockey community to children and families in need. This year, the event will benefit Building on Love, Capital Cup for Kids, Make A Wish of Northeast NY, and other local organizations. 400+ players make up 24 teams, competing in six divisions, and they will all be vying for their names on the Capital Cup as well as for the bragging rights as the tourney's largest fundraiser.
